Present continuous Right now, at the moment, currently	To be + stam + ing I am eating You are eating He/she/it is eating We are eating You are eating They are eating	De present continuous gebruik je voor iets wat op dit moment aan de gang is, voor een vaststaand plan in de nabije toekomst of voor een irritatie.	I am eating my breakfast at the moment . Is she going to the party? He is always teasing me! (irritatie)
Past simple Yesterday, last week, last year, two hours ago	Bij regelmatige werkwoorden: Stam + ed <u>To walk -> walked</u> Bij onregelmatige werkwoorden: 2 ^e rijtje <u>Go -> went</u>	De past simple gebruik je voor een afgesloten handeling in het verleden. Het is dus al voorbij!	I had a bath yesterday . We went to New York last week . <i>Let op: bij vragen/ontkenningen gebruik je did of didn't.</i> Did he go to the party last Friday ? I didn't do my homework for today.
Past continuous While, when, as Staat in combinatie met de past simple!	Was/were + stam + ing I was doing You were doing He/she/it was doing We were doing You were doing They were doing	De past continuous gebruik je voor iets wat in het verleden aan de gang was.	<u>While</u> her mother was cooking dinner, Fiona was doing her homework. I was cleaning my room <u>when</u> Joey called.
Present perfect (simple) For, yet, since, never, ever, already, before, recently, lately	Bij regelmatige werkwoorden: To have + stam + ed <u>To walk -> I have walked</u> Bij onregelmatige werkwoorden: To have + 3 ^e rijtje <u>Toe at -> I have eaten</u>	De present perfect gebruik je voor een gebeurtenis die in het verleden is begonnen, maar nu nog voortduurt. Of het resultaat van iets is nu nog merkbaar.	They have lived here <u>for two years</u> . He has cut himself in his finger. I have never eaten snails before. Have you already finished your homework?
Present perfect continuous For, since, up till now, recently, lately	Has/have + been + stam + ing I have been doing You have been doing He/she/it has been doing We have been doing You have been doing They have been doing	De present perfect continuous gebruik je als iets in het verleden is gebeurd en continu aan de gang is geweest, tot nu. De nadruk ligt op korte duur en continuïteit.	I have been waiting for the bus <u>for two hours</u> . I have been doing my English homework <u>up till now</u> . <u>Recently</u> , all she has been thinking about was the break-up.

<p>Present future perfect (simple)</p> <p>Bepaald moment in de toekomst: next week, by next June, tomorrow</p>	<p>Bij regelmatige werkwoorden: Will + have + stam + ed <u>To walk -> I will have walked</u></p> <p>Bij onregelmatige werkwoorden: Will + have + 3^e rijtje <u>To eat -> I will have eaten</u></p>	<p>De present future perfect gebruik je voor een gebeurtenis waarvan je zeker weet dat hij op een bepaald moment in de toekomst gebeurd zal zijn.</p>	<p><u>By next June</u>, they will have finished this project.</p> <p><u>Around this time tomorrow</u>, I will have spoken to my boss.</p>
<p>Present future perfect continuous</p> <p>Bepaald moment in de toekomst: by 2025, at six o'clock, when I come back</p>	<p>Will + have + been + stam + ing</p> <p>I will have been doing You will have been doing He/she/it will have been doing We will have been doing You will have been doing They will have been doing</p>	<p>De present future perfect continuous gebruik je voor iets waar je op een bepaald moment in de toekomst mee bezig bent geweest.</p>	<p><u>By 2022</u>, I will have been working here for six years.</p> <p><u>At 3 o'clock</u>, he will have been waiting here for two hours.</p> <p><u>When we finish this course</u>, we will have been learning English for ten years.</p>
<p>Past perfect</p> <p>after, before, when, as soon as, by the time that</p>	<p>Bij regelmatige werkwoorden: Had + stam + ed <u>To walk -> I had walked</u></p> <p>Bij onregelmatige werkwoorden: Had + 3^e rijtje <u>To eat -> I had eaten</u></p>	<p>De past perfect gebruik je voor een gebeurtenis die in het verleden is begonnen én afgerond. <i>Staat vaak in combinatie met de past simple. De ene handeling gebeurt dan vóór de andere.</i></p>	<p><u>After he had walked</u> to school, he made his English exam.</p> <p><u>Before I had taken</u> piano lessons, I could not play any music at all.</p>
<p>Past perfect continuous</p> <p>when, before, for several hours, for a few days</p> <p><i>Een zin met een past perfect continuous, in combinatie met een past simple</i></p>	<p>Had + been + stam + ing</p> <p>I had been working You had been working He/she/it had been working We had been working You had been working They had been working</p>	<p>De past perfect continuous gebruik je voor een handeling die in het verleden een tijdje aan de gang is geweest, maar nu afgesloten is.</p>	<p>When he called me, I had been sleeping all day.</p> <p>Had you been waiting long before the bus arrived?</p> <p>It had been raining for several hours and the streets were very wet.</p>
